





ORDER

By order dated March 5, 2026, this matter was dismissed due to Petitioner's failure to timely submit the filing fee for her petition for a writ of certiorari as required by Rule 242(c), SCACR. Additionally, Fiscal Services for the Judicial Branch reports that the check provided by Petitioner for the filing fee was rejected by her financial institution due to her account having insufficient funds.
