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Hello,

Attia Elbadawy, hereby gives notice that he is opening a new appeal case from the May 7,2026 Order issued by Honorable Judge Goodstein regarding the denial of injunctive relief in the Quiet Title Action involving Wise Lane. The appeal will be filed with the South Carolina Court of Appeals and will challenge the lower court's denial of the requested injunction, including issues concerning ownership, access, status quo preservation, and alleged improper actions affecting Wise Lane during pending litigation.

Under South Carolina appellate procedure, a Notice of Appeal must generally be served within thirty (30) days after written notice of entry of the order being appealed.

South Carolina appellate rules also recognize that appeals involving injunction orders are treated differently from ordinary civil orders and may require additional motions regarding stays or supersedeas during the appeal process.
