Hello Mrs Harrison, I'm hoping my Previous letters made it to you. I am writing you now to Clarify some things about my appeal. I already wrote a "Preliminary Brief." It should be in the Clerks folder. Everything I did is in Pencil, because for whatever reason they wont let us use ink.

As far as subpoenas go, I mentioned them in my "issues on appeal." It is necessary to note that I did initially draft and design my own subpoenas, however they were not willing to serve them. After filing a motion requesting subpoenas was granted, I was then given subpoenas by the clerk, which I filled out, and she certified, and placed the seal of the court, and then I had them served via pre-paid postage. It was these subpoenas that were disregarded. I think the Police wanted to blame some arbitrary subjective issuing because they dont feel like they should be accountable to tax paying citizens, but once again Erickson v. Pardus should alleviate any of their concerns.

In my opinion, and what I would prefer to happen, as well as what would be most fair, is that a mistrial should be declared, or the charges dismissed for government misconduct. Now that I've conducted a trial, I know how it works. Which means I know what I did wrong, what I would change, what and how questions I should ask etc. The trials should have been severed like the Judge did to the other charge, etc. Quite frankly if I could redo that trial from the free world I would have completely obliterated the OAG and they would be embarrassed for listening to those people. Cofty admitted to criminal activity, on the stand. She should have been arrested I was rushed to end the trial etc. I was a bit pressured by the state to wrap it up. In hind-sight the cases should have been severed, and I could have had a better outcome. There was a collective effort to protect Cofty, and obstruct justice.
