The Court received your \$250 filing fee for your notice of appeal. As stated in this Court's letter dated May 6, 2026, upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies remain under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and these deficiencies must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- You must serve Respondent's attorney with a copy of the notice of appeal via USPS mail. The proof of service you provided is not in compliance with SCACR. Specifically, pursuant to Rule 262(c)(3), SCACR, and Re: Methods of Electronic Filing & Service Under Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated May 6, 2022, only lawyers admitted to practice in South Carolina may serve other lawyers using the lawyer's primary email address in AIS.
- Your notice of appeal must include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment you are appealing.
- You must sign the notice of appeal. *See* Rule 267(b), SCACR.

- You must provide proof of filing the notice of appeal with the Lexington County Clerk of Court.
