I was handed down the sentencing of 90 days jail time (to be served on the weekend), three (3) years probation, 40 hours of community service, and a 12:00am curfew. I've apologized profusely to the court and the arresting officer.

Yes, on May 2 my actions were far from anything to be proud of. I am a single father raising a 5 year-old son, whom I am focused on being a positive role model to. My Monday - Friday work schedule ends between 4:30 - 5:30 daily and my Saturday work schedule ends between 12:30 - 1:30. This leaves me very little time to spend with my son, whom I am the primary caregiver. I have to render responsibilities to my mother or friends until my Sunday release.

I ask that the court appeal my case, so that the fact of me being a first time offender will be taken into consideration. I look forward to a positive response.
