## ORDER

---

Appellants filed a motion for leave to file a motion pursuant to Rule 60(b) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure. *See* Rule 60(b), SCACR (explaining that "[d]uring the pendency of an appeal, leave to make the motion must be obtained from the appellate court"). Respondents filed a return in opposition and Appellants filed a reply. After careful consideration, we grant Appellants' motion. Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellants shall file and serve their Rule 60(b) motion. This appeal shall be held in abeyance pending the circuit court's ruling on the motion. Appellants shall provide this court with a status update every thirty days, and Appellant shall provide this court with the circuit court's ruling on the motion within ten days of receipt of the circuit court's written order. Failure to do so may result in dismissal of this appeal.<sup>1</sup>
