**NOTICE OF DISPUTED POST-APPEAL ORDERS
AND CONTINUED CAPTION DISPUTE**

Appellant, Pro se, Attia Elbadawy hereby submits this Notice regarding additional orders entered by the lower court on May 26, 2026, after the filing of the Notice of Appeal in the above-captioned matter presently pending before the South Carolina Court of Appeals. Appellant, expressly disputes the lower court's authority to issue additional substantive rulings affecting matters already under appellate review and appellate jurisdiction. Appellant, does not concede the validity, correctness, or procedural propriety of such orders and objects to any interpretation suggesting agreement with the lower court's findings, reasoning, or conclusions. This notice is submitted solely to preserve the procedural history and to advise the appellate court of continued lower court activity occurring after the Notice of Appeal was filed. Appellant, maintains that the appealed matters are presently before the Court of Appeals and that the lower court's continued substantive rulings improperly interfere with issues already under appellate consideration. Appellant, further continues to dispute the incorrect appellate caption

reflected within portions of the appellate docketing system. Appellant, has repeatedly requested correction of the caption to reflect Dorchester County before D.R. Horton, Inc., consistent with the filings submitted by Appellant, and the order in which the parties were presented in the Notice of Appeal and related appellate documents.
