
TO: Defendant, Brandon White, his attorney Charles Snyder, and Aladdin Bail Bonds:

YOU WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on the 31st day of May, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., the State of South Carolina, through its undersigned attorney, will move before the Presiding Judge for the Court of General Sessions for Spartanburg County, for an order revoking the bond set for the said Defendant on the above-enumerated charges, at a hearing in the Spartanburg County Courthouse located at 180 Magnolia Street, Spartanburg. If you fail to appear at this hearing, the state will request a bench warrant for your arrest and/or will ask to hold the hearing in your absent.

The State of South Carolina hereby moves this Court for an order revoking the current bond of the above-named defendant. This motion is made pursuant to Sections 17-15-40, 17-15-50, and 17-15-55 Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended. The State alleges that the above-named Defendant has violated the good behavior provision of his bond and presents a danger to the community in which he resides for the following reasons:

- 1) On November 16, 2023 the Defendant was arrested and charged with Breaching of Peace High and Aggravated, Unlawful Carry of a Pistol, Discharging Firearm into Occupied Vehicle. The incident occurred on October 18, 2023. He was given a \$25,000 surety bond and released from custody on November 22, 2023.
- 2) The conditions of bond for the above referenced charge stated, "Defendant shall be released from custody on the condition that he ... be of good behavior."
- 3) The State would show the Defendant was arrested on May 1, 2024 and charged with Use of Vehicle Without Consent and a Probation Violation. He was issued a \$2,500 surety bond. At the time of the filing of this motion he is Spartanburg County Detention Center.
- 4) The State would further show the Defendant was served a warrant on May 14, 2024 for Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and Petit Larceny Enhanced for an incident that occurred on April 2, 2024
- 5) Therefore, the Defendant has violated the good behavior provision of his bond. The State respectfully moves to revoke the Defendant's bond.

This matter was before the court for hearing on motion of the State to revoke bond. The defendant did not appear but was represented by **CHAD SNYDER, Esq. SPENSER SMITH** of the office of the Circuit Solicitor appeared for the State.

The defendant is charged with the crime(s) of **BREACH OF PEACE HIGH AND AGGRAVATE, DISCHARGING INTO A VEHICLE, AND UNLAWFUL CARRY**. He was released from pretrial detention by the execution of surety bonds providing for the conditions of release and which included that he **"BE OF GOOD BEHAVIOR."**


The State now moves for a revocation of bond asserting the existence of probable cause to believe that the defendant has violated the conditions of release by **CONTINUING TO ENGAGE IN CRIMINAL CONDUCT, AS EVIDENCED BY THE FACT WAS ARRESTED FOR USE OF VEHICLE WITHOUT CONSENT ON MAY 1, 2024 AND BURGLARY 1<sup>ST</sup> DEGREE AND PETIT LARCENY ENHANCED ON MAY 14, 2024.**

After considering the presentation made by the State and the defendant and after considering the nature and circumstances of the offense(s) charged; the defendant's character and mental condition; prior criminal history; compliance or failure to comply with the conditions of release and any reason(s) given therefore; any risk of flight and/or unreasonable risk to the community or a particular individual resulting from his/her continued release on bond, this Court finds that good cause has been shown for a revocation of bail.

2 THE COURT: You are Mr. Brandon White. Is that  
3 correct?

4 MR. WHITE: Yes, sir.

5 THE COURT: Mr. White, I just need to let you know we  
6 are making a recording of everything that happens here today.  
7 To be sure that it gets recorded, speak towards that green  
8 light that's on that microphone. You don't have to lean into  
9 it, but just sort of speak towards it. But -- but similarly,  
10 Mr. White, if ever during this process you can't hear me or  
11 one of the lawyers, immediately let us know, and we'll speak  
12 up as well, okay?

13 MR. WHITE: Yes, sir.

14 THE COURT: Thank you, sir. Mr. White, to start the  
15 process, the clerk of court needs to swear you in. Please  
16 raise your right hand.

17 BRANDON KEVON WHITE,

18 being duly sworn, testified as follows:

19 THE CLERK: Thank you.

20 THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. White. Mr. White, please  
21 listen to the Solicitor. He is going to announce the cases  
22 for us.

23 MR. SMITH: Your Honor, Mr. White is here on four  
24 indictments. They've all been true billed. First is  
25 2024-GS-42-1854. That's a true-billed indictment for

1 discharging a firearm into a vehicle, and he is pleading as  
2 indicted with a negotiated 10-year sentence to run concurrent  
3 with all of the other sentences other than the petty larceny,  
4 which is going to be a consecutive. And, your Honor,  
5 2024-GS-4262 -- excuse me, 2622 -- 2024-GS-42-2622 is a true-  
6 billed indictment for breach of peace, high and aggravated.  
7 He is pleading as indicted with a concurrent 10-year  
8 sentence. He is also before the Court on 2024-GS-42-3679.  
9 That is a true-billed indictment for burglary in the first  
10 degree. He is pleading to the lesser included offense of  
11 burglary, second degree, violent, with a negotiated 15-year  
12 sentence. And then finally, 2024-GS-42-3680 is a petty  
13 larceny enhanced charge, your Honor. He is pleading to that  
14 as charged. It's true billed. And that is a five-year  
15 consecutive sentence to all others. So the -- the two 10 and  
16 the 15-year sentence will run concurrent, and then a  
17 five-year consecutive sentence to all those on the petty  
18 larceny. State is dismissing a use of vehicle without  
19 consent and a unlawful carry charge as a part of the plea.

20 Your Honor, he has done pretrial detention. The  
21 State's position in -- with section 24-13-40 is that he is  
22 not entitled to that pretrial credit because he was -- both  
23 number three and number four, he was arrested while -- he  
24 committed additional offenses. He was arrested while out on  
25 bond, and has had his bond revoked based off of those new

1 charges. But, your Honor, for the -- for the Court's  
2 information -- let me see. He did 35 days in jail when he  
3 was initially arrested on the breach of peace and discharging  
4 incident, and then he was arrested on May 1st for the use of  
5 vehicle without cons -- well, he was arrested on May 14th for  
6 the burglary, which would be 373 days that he's been in on  
7 that burglary charge.

8 Your Honor, I don't have the victim present. This is  
9 -- was first up for trial docket next week. And I'm  
10 comfortable that the negotiations are consistent with the  
11 conversations I've had with the victim about how to resolve  
12 this case.

13 THE COURT: All right. Thank you.

14 MR. SMITH: Thank you, your Honor.

15 THE COURT: Mr. White, it is your intent to enter a  
16 plea to the charges that were just announced?

17 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

18 THE COURT: Okay. How old are you?

19 THE WITNESS: 36.

20 THE COURT: And how far did you go in school?

21 THE WITNESS: I completed GED.

22 THE COURT: How far did you go before you stopped  
23 school?

24 THE WITNESS: 12.

25 THE COURT: Well, presently, are you married, single,

1 divorced, or widowed?

2 THE WITNESS: I'm single.

3 THE COURT: Do you have any children?

4 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

5 THE COURT: How many?

6 THE WITNESS: Three.

7 THE COURT: How old are they?

8 THE WITNESS: 19, 2, and 2.

9 THE COURT: And prior to being arrested on these  
10 charges, did you have a job outside of the home?

11 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

12 THE COURT: What kind of work were you doing?

13 THE WITNESS: I was a chef at the Peach Blossoms.

14 THE COURT: Ever serve in the military?

15 THE WITNESS: No, sir.

16 THE COURT: Within the last 24 hours, have you consumed  
17 any type of substance that's adversely or negatively  
18 affecting your ability to understand what we're doing today?

19 THE WITNESS: No, sir.

20 THE COURT: In the past, have you ever received any  
21 substance abuse treatment for drug or alcohol problem?

22 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

23 THE COURT: Was that for drugs, alcohol, or both?

24 THE WITNESS: It was for both.

25 THE COURT: Where did you receive that last treatment?

1 THE WITNESS: Morris Village.

2 THE COURT: And about how long ago was that,  
3 approximately?

4 THE WITNESS: 2013.

5 THE COURT: And when you finished that program in 2013,  
6 did you consider it to be a success at that time?

7 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

8 THE COURT: All right. Are you satisfied with the work  
9 that your lawyer has done for you?

10 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

11 THE COURT: Have any -- has anybody come to you and  
12 threatened you in any way, or promised you anything in order  
13 to get you to make the decision to enter the plea today?

14 THE WITNESS: No, sir.

15 THE COURT: Am I correct to conclude that your decision  
16 to enter the plea today that it is a free and voluntary  
17 decision by you?

18 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

19 THE COURT: Mr. White, I need for you to understand  
20 that under the law you are presumed innocent of all these  
21 charges, and you are entitled to have a jury trial on any or  
22 all these charges. At any jury trial that would take place,  
23 it would be the State that has the burden of proof, and they  
24 would have to convince all 12 members of a jury that you are  
25 in fact guilty beyond a reasonable doubt. Now do you

1 understand that you have a right to that jury trial?

2 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

3 THE COURT: And do you wish to give up your right to  
4 that jury trial and go forward with these pleas?

5 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

6 THE COURT: Sir, I need for you to understand that  
7 there are other very important constitutional rights that you  
8 are entitled to, but that you have to give up in order to  
9 enter these pleas. You have to give up your right to  
10 confront and cross-examine the State's witnesses. You also  
11 have to give up your right to present evidence, which you or  
12 your lawyer might feel would establish a defense. And you  
13 have to give up your right of subpoena as well as your right  
14 to remain silent. Now Mr. White, do you understand all those  
15 rights?

16 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

17 THE COURT: And you wish to give up those rights and go  
18 forward with these pleas?

19 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

20 THE COURT: Thank you for answering those questions,  
21 Mr. White. I'm going to ask you if you would please listen  
22 to the Solicitor again. He's going to give us the facts that  
23 are behind these cases, okay?

24 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

25 THE COURT: Thank you.

1           MR. SMITH: Your Honor, the breach of peace and  
2           discharging into a vehicle occurred on October 18th, 2023.  
3           City officers responded to Duncan and Cornell Streets in the  
4           City and County of Spartanburg for a shooting. Two gunshot  
5           victims were transported to Spartanburg Regional. The  
6           Defendant was one of them, along with another male. They  
7           arrived in a Ford Escort. The other male stated that they  
8           were hanging out at a boarding house when they were  
9           threatened with a gun by a black male. He and the Defendant  
10          went to a friend's house, and the Defendant got a gun. The  
11          Defendant then stated, "There they go. Get him." And he  
12          began pursuing the Jeep and truck that had threatened him.  
13          The Defendant began shooting, and the other cars were firing  
14          back at them.

15                 This defendant admitted to shooting but said it was in  
16          self-defense. He didn't know who he was shooting at. They  
17          were able to obtain surveillance from a house which showed  
18          the Ford Escort speeding behind the Jeep and truck, with the  
19          Defendant hanging out of the passenger side firing a weapon.  
20          They were never able to identify who the people were in that  
21          car. That's why he didn't get higher charges. That was  
22          essentially all they felt that they could prove. Given the  
23          lack of cooperation from the purported victims, though,  
24          probably everybody involved would've been considered a  
25          defendant, based off of the facts, your Honor.

1           On April 3rd, 2024 -- this is the burglary and petty  
2 larceny, deputies responded to [REDACTED] Bryant Road in Spartanburg  
3 County for a burglary. The victim stated he and his  
4 girlfriend had left the house the day before around 6:00 p.m.  
5 When they returned the next day at 2:45 in the morning, and  
6 the front door was open, and the doorframe was broken, he  
7 noticed several items including a TV and PlayStation were  
8 missing. He stated a man named "Chuck" -- which is a  
9 nickname associated with Mr. White, may be the suspect. He  
10 stated he had been squatting in a nearby unit, and that he  
11 used to give him rides when he needed it, but had recently  
12 stopped.

13           He stated he spoke to Chuck in the parking lot prior to  
14 leaving the night of the burglary. Chuck had asked for a  
15 ride, he refused, and Chuck appeared offended. The Defendant  
16 was picked up on other charges and investigators went to  
17 speak with him. He did admit to entering the apartment and  
18 stole a PS5 and a TV. He stated he did it because the victim  
19 owed him money for marijuana. He indicated that it happened  
20 during the day, and that he had basically watched and waited  
21 for them to leave and then did it. Your Honor, the  
22 enhancement is based off of two prior. So that would be a  
23 part of the factual presentation. I do have the rest of his  
24 record at the appropriate time, but that would be the only  
25 enhancer, so...

1 THE COURT: Thank you, sir.

2 MR. SMITH: Yes, your Honor.

3 THE COURT: Mr. White, you were able to hear the  
4 Solicitor when he told me the facts?

5 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

6 THE COURT: Do you believe that as he stated the facts  
7 to me, that he is substantially correct with those facts?

8 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

9 THE COURT: And sir, do you understand that these  
10 pleas, they are being presented to me as negotiated,  
11 therefore, if I accept the pleas, I will be bound by the  
12 negotiations, and I will impose the sentence that was  
13 announced by the Solicitor. Do you understand that?

14 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

15 THE COURT: And that is what you wish for me to do?

16 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

17 THE COURT: And sir, do you understand that the  
18 burglary, second degree, violent, charge, that it is  
19 classified under the law as both a violent and also as a  
20 serious offense?

21 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

22 THE COURT: And would that under -- and -- and you've  
23 been able to talk to your lawyer as to the consequences of  
24 those two classifications?

25 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

1 THE COURT: And you still wish to enter that plea?

2 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

3 THE COURT: Sir, are you in fact guilty of this  
4 burglary, second degree, violent, charge?

5 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

6 THE COURT: Are you also guilty of the discharging  
7 firearm at, or into an occupied vehicle charge?

8 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

9 THE COURT: And are you also guilty of this breach of  
10 trust of high and aggravated nature charge?

11 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

12 THE COURT: And are you also guilty of this petty  
13 larceny, third and subsequent, property enhanced case?

14 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

15 THE COURT: Sir, have all of your answers to my  
16 questions -- so far today, have they been truthful and  
17 honest?

18 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

19 THE COURT: Discovery has been shared with the Defense?

20 MR. SMITH: It has, your Honor.

21 THE COURT: Well, prior record?

22 MR. SMITH: 2011, two forgeries, obtaining goods under  
23 false pretenses, and a burglary, second, nonviolent. 2015,  
24 burglary, third, first offense, and petty larceny. 2019,  
25 assault and battery, second, common law robbery, distribution

1 of an imitation substance, stalking, driving under  
2 suspension, false info, three shopliftings, and two obtaining  
3 goods under false pretenses. In 2020, another shoplifting.

4 THE COURT: And I know that you told me about the  
5 victim, you felt was in agreement with the cases. Anything  
6 -- with the negotiations, anything else from the victims I  
7 need to know about?

8 MR. SMITH: I don't -- I don't have any additional  
9 information, your Honor.

10 THE COURT: All right. Thank you, sir. Yes, sir.

11 MR. ALLEN: Your Honor, Mr. White indicated he's 36  
12 years old, does have three children, ages 19, a son, Jamari,  
13 and lives with his dad now.

14 THE COURT: Mr. Allen, let me get you to do this. Move  
15 that microphone a little bit closer. There you go. Thank  
16 you.

17 MR. ALLEN: 19-year-old son, Jamari, and lives with his  
18 father Calvin in -- in Orangeburg, and two daughters, Anari  
19 and Malia, both live locally in Lawrence and Woodruff. He  
20 said he was a chef at the Peach Blossoms because he went to  
21 culinary school, your Honor. And I really talked to him  
22 about hopefully trying to continue that education and -- and  
23 pursue something there when he -- when he is released. I'd  
24 like to first take up the matter of the pretrial credit,  
25 which is actually a total of 422 days, I believe me -- me and

1 Mr. Smith were in agreement on that being the time that he's  
2 been incarcerated. We're in disagreement, however, on how  
3 much credit of that time that -- that he would have. It's  
4 our position that he's been incarcerated for 422 days.

5 And so, certainly, pursuant to his constitutional  
6 rights, I -- I believe that he would be entitled to -- to  
7 that credit. He hadn't been free, so he's been in custody of  
8 the State for 422 days prior to today's hearing. Also would  
9 like to place on the record this morning, myself and Mr.  
10 Smith had discussed some release dates regarding the  
11 calculator from the SCDC. We discussed May the 23rd, 2025,  
12 being today, he'd be starting his burglary, second, violent,  
13 sentence. And that sentence is to be terminated -- according  
14 to our discussions based upon this calculator, on November  
15 the 8th, 2032, when he would begin his consecutive petty  
16 larceny sentence. And I'd like to place on the record that  
17 the calculator once shows again that -- that the possible  
18 release date with that sentence, and him being released from  
19 custody be May 13th, 2035, your Honor.

20 I'll just say Mr. White's always been very -- very  
21 pleasant with me. He's readily admitted responsibility for  
22 the -- for the charges here today. I -- I don't have  
23 anything negative to say about him. He's -- I've spoken with  
24 his uncle. Very -- very nice person. I believe that -- that  
25 when he is released, he's going to be fine. But -- but once

1 again, your Honor, the -- the -- the pretrial credit, we  
2 would like to request a full 422 days that -- that he was  
3 incarcerated. Thank you.

4 THE COURT: Thank you, sir. Mr. White, do you agree  
5 with the statements that were just made by your lawyer?

6 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.

7 THE COURT: Mr. White, is there anything else that you  
8 would like to say or want me to know or consider?

9 THE WITNESS: I learned my lesson, and I apologize for  
10 the things that -- you know, I did, and it won't happen  
11 again.

12 THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. White. I find that there is  
13 a substantial factual basis for the plea, and that the  
14 Defendant's decision to enter the plea is made freely,  
15 voluntarily, knowingly, and intellectually by him.  
16 Therefore, I will accept the plea. On the burglary, second  
17 degree, violent, charge, that will be a 15-year sentence at  
18 the State Department of Corrections, and run concurrent with  
19 the discharge of firearm into an occupied vehicle, which is a  
20 10-year sentence. It runs concurrent with the breach of  
21 peace, high aggravated nature, which is also a 10-year  
22 sentence. Consecutive to those three cases, is the five-year  
23 sentence on the petty larceny enhanced case -- again, runs  
24 consecutive to the other sentences. I will take a look at  
25 the issue of credit, and -- and let you all know about that.

1 I got to review the statute and stuff. Sir, if you have any  
2 questions about anything that we've done today, please speak  
3 with your lawyer, but I wish you the best of luck.

4 THE WITNESS: Thank you, your Honor.

5 THE COURT: Thank you.





**NOTICE OF APPEAL**

Brandon Kevon White appeals the Order issued by the Honorable J. Mark Hayes II on June 12, 2025 denying credit for time he spent incarcerated in the Spartanburg County Detention Center prior to his plea hearing in the Court of General Sessions in Spartanburg County on May 23, 2025. Mr. White was charged with Discharging a Firearm into a Vehicle, Unlawful Carry of a Firearm, and Breach of Peace of a High and Aggravated Nature on November 16, 2023. Mr. White was subsequently released on bond for these charges on November 23, 2023. Bond for these charges was ordered to be revoked on June 10, 2024. Pursuant to the Order to Revoke Bond, Mr. White remained incarcerated until pleading guilty to these charges on May 23, 2025. The calculated period for this time was 347 days. The State's assertion at Mr. White's plea hearing was that, pursuant to §24-12-40 (3) and (4), Mr. White was not entitled to receive credit for the time he remained incarcerated in the Spartanburg County Detention Center subsequent to the bond revocation order issued on June 10, 2024. The Defense contends Mr. White should be entitled to receive 347 days of pre-trial credit for the time he spent incarcerated subsequent to bond revocation. Moreover, the denial of credit for the time Mr. White was incarcerated during this time period would violate his constitutional rights.



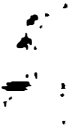


