ORDER

On April 6, 2026, Appellant filed two motions. The first motion, a "Motion for Protective Order and for Allowance of Costs, Fees, and Expenses," seeks a protective order requiring the South Carolina Department of Corrections to comply with their legal photocopies policy provisions and to provide Appellant with photocopies of any pleadings and documents relevant to the appeal and to waive the costs, fees, and expenses related to the ordering of the transcript of the November 3, 2025 hearing. The second motion, a "Motion to Stay Time for Ordering Transcript," seeks a stay of the time to order the transcript while this court considers the first motion to waive transcript costs. No returns were filed.

After careful consideration, we deny both April 6, 2026 motions. Further, Appellant shall provide proof of ordering the transcript within ten days of the date of this order or the appeal will be dismissed.
