

## ORDER

---

Appellant filed a notice of appeal in a criminal action. On April 16, 2026, Appellant filed a motion to transfer her case to the United States District Court of South Carolina "under Rule 42 US Code 1983 [and] Rule federal law (28 U.S.C. § 1441 and § 1446)." Respondent did not file a return. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion. *See* 28 U.S. Code § 1441 ("... any *civil action* brought in a State court of which the district courts of the United States have original jurisdiction, may be removed by the defendant or the defendants . . . ." (emphasis added)); 28 U.S. Code § 1446 ("A defendant or defendants desiring to remove any *civil action* from a State court shall file in the district court of the United States for the district and division within which such action is pending a notice of removal . . . ." (emphasis added)).
