You recently inquired about the status of your complaint about Mr. Aiken. The rules of the Supreme Court of South Carolina establishing disciplinary enforcement procedures for lawyers impose certain confidentiality restrictions on the Office of the Disciplinary Counsel. As a result, access to disciplinary information is limited. This office is prohibited from providing complainants information about a particular complaint unless it is necessary to pursue our investigation. Complainants are advised of significant developments in cases to the extent the rules permit and are always advised as to the final dispositions of their complaints.

I can tell you that this matter is the subject of an on-going investigation by this office. If it is necessary for a field investigation to be conducted, you will be contacted by an investigator or an Attorney to Assist Disciplinary Counsel. If this case is scheduled for a hearing before a hearing panel, you will be notified. If it is closed, you will be advised.

Under the Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement published by the Supreme Court of South Carolina (Rule 413, SCACR), "complaints" from individuals are actually "information" to the Commission on Lawyer Conduct. Under these rules, only the Disciplinary Counsel can file formal charges to bring matters for a hearing before the Commission and, in doing so, Disciplinary Counsel seeks to protect the public as a whole through the promotion of institutional values rather than obtaining relief for any individual complainant.



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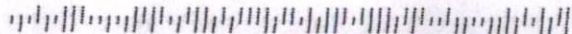
