ORDER

On April 27, 2026, Appellant filed the record on appeal. On April 28, 2026, Appellant filed a "motion to correct or modify the record on appeal," stating the record contained materials outside the trial court record. Specifically, Appellant asked this court to disregard or strike pages 105-113 and 360-375 of the record on appeal. On May 8, 2026, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss the appeal, arguing Appellant improperly included pages 104-113 and 360-376 in the record on appeal. In the alternative, Respondent moved this court to strike those pages from the record on appeal. On May 12, 2026, Appellant filed a return to Respondent's motion to dismiss, arguing a less drastic remedy was available. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss the appeal and grant Appellant's motion to strike pages 105-113 and 360-375 from the record on appeal.¹ Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that omits those pages.
