This is the direct appeal to a civil forfeiture that occurred on 9/19/22 where I was illegally arrested. I was illegally arrested because they only had an arrest warrant for another person named Marcus Barlow. The Dep Matthew C Smith injured me first violating my rights, then after injuring me knowing & seeing that I was injured after the seizure he got a Search Warrant & found drugs not mine in the suspects home with a guns in a safe, money in a safe inside a combination coded handbag & 2 cellphones that I didn't come out the house with or run with because I didn't want to be searched. I was seized when the deputies blocked the car in I drove from the back & blocked off the driveway unlawfully an illegally without probable cause of seeing the suspect Mr Barlow. The probable cause tickets of my arrest have been expunged (19) & dismissed (22) but the Judge ordered a direct Indictment (18) that was brought back up at trial, (16) resisting arrest causing double jeopardy. No drugs was found on me or in my safe or bag. I saved up old collectable bills for years from unemployment benefits, babysitting (2), lawncare maintenance, & tax refunds with picture proof in my phone being exculpatory evidence destroyed of my jobs. I saved up old collectable & 50 dollar bills from the 1970's & 1980's. The prosecutor didn't bring the collectable 100's or criminal trial misconduct shown & put the funds into an account without BWC of the Search & Seizure (28) destroying the safe & the home ripping the walls in the trailer an destroying the front door. The first problem is that Barry J Barrette never produced my old collectable bills as evidence because of the money not being held as evidence for trial. The money is favorable to me & to my civil & criminal case. I had substantial rights violated of the defendant (def), me, resulting in actual prejudice surprising the def at court with a trial for just a supposed motion, then forced a trial when I was telling the Judge that I was in need of counsel, because of my mental health & brain injuries an that my rights are being violated. Trial court Judge Derham Cole Jr hindered my ability to prepare for my defense after being told that I had a mental disability, brain injury, physical disability, & needed a counsel objecting to his motion for a civil forfeiture. The Judge allowed Christopher Rojas testimony without allowing me to put his statement in evidence even after his misconduct fabricating the supplemental report (36) that Barlow fled the scene & Craig Brenton was detained, being two suspects on the scene & that he purposely destroyed a phone in evidence causing affirmative misconduct employee misconduct, official misconduct, serious & willful misconduct also. Dep Rojas didn't have BWC on 5 min before the search or 5 min after the search to show the time of the search, to show destruction of the bag, safe, an stealing of funds from the evidence being 7,000, & the destruction of the trailer walls that got the suspect (Barlow) evicted. All of the Deputies (37) besides Matthew C Smith violated code 23-1-240 wearing no BWC violates policies & procedures of a person whose property has been seized or damaged in relation to, or is otherwise involved with a crime to which the recording is related is a Due Process violation with bad faith. The Judge didn't allow me to put in evidence (24) of my mental disability (21) health disability. I also wasn't allowed to put in evidence (26) misconduct of the Judge conspiring with lawyers. There is prosecutorial misconduct allowing (36) Rojas to destroy & steal exculpatory evidence causing prosecutor misconduct, I was also interrupted & my microphone was cut off by the deputies when I told them I wanted legal counsel & that my rights are being violated, but Judge allowed the trial instead of just a motion. The Judge also didn't allow my motions pages 1 off through 4 of 4 sent with this direct appeal. I need a jury trial not a trial by Judge. I also am showing an sending (1) the motion hearing not a trial hearing. I'm also sending (2) the Denard letter sent on 10/1/23 by certified letter sent on 10/5/23 (2). I did state on the record of the intro of my speech when I objected that the case should be thrown out because of obstruction of justice, obstruction of evidence, & tampering with a witness then I was objected, The state failed to establish probable cause, the money proceeds not traceable to illegal drug transactions being the probable cause charges are expunged & dismissed with proof. I want these 50 pages filed in my direct appeal for civil case: 2022CP-204835 & please add these 50 pgs to the case No: 2026-000808 as added to the pending direct appeal. Please notarize all & send back copies notarized. I'm also sending 6 Affidavits & proof files also needed to be added.

seized in violation of the amendment be excluded from trial. I need a writ of
Habeas Corpus? The place searched was shut & locked on should have actual &
reasonable expectation of privacy being the place asked to search before my seizure.
There is errors & prejudice an should be a mistrial. There is no probable cause
for the S&S (search & seizure) being dismissed & expunged by Judge Charles Bywell.
The civil forfeiture has a binding effect on the subsequent criminal trial. The
results of the proceeding would have been different if the phone wasn't
destroyed & the money would have been presented at trial to show the collectable
money stolen from a closed safe. The evidence was in possession of the state
& would have effected the outcome of this trial & the criminal trial. There
is 37 pages of crucial evidence needed to file today to prove this case has
also Double Jeopardy clause violations also. I was not the suspect when
I ran & I wasn't under arrest when I ran to make this arrest lawful
in other words an arrest wasn't being made when I ran from the police to challenge

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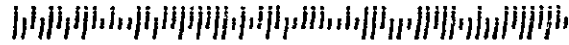

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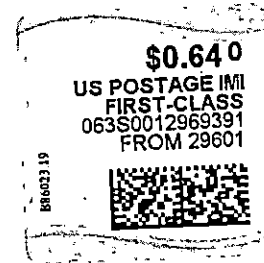


This motion is for Brady violations, motion for a evidentiary hearing request (franks hearing) dealing with illegal Search & seizure (S&S) an ineffective counsel, motion to subpoena 2020-22 unemployment & social security income, & motion to suppress all evidence under the fruits of a poisonous tree doctrine. This is my 2nd motion on the record to suppress all evidence found on 9/19/22 during an illegal S&S with excessive force (ECF). Dep. Matthew C Smith unlawfully blocked the driveway & ^{drove} car by Mr. Brewton, seizing Mr Brewton, the car, & the home of the suspect on the warrant, also with photographs to identify the difference between Mr Barlow & Mr Brewton. The sheriff officers had an arrest warrant for Marcus David Ross Barlow without probable cause (PC) to believe Mr Barlow was in his home without a positive ID. Mr. Barlow was never on the scene making the S&S invalid, illegal, unlawful, without exigent circumstances, & making Christopher Rojas police report false about Mr. Barlow being on the scene fleeing. The officers also broke into an also confiscated legal money from a combination coded bag (safe) & a sentry safe both locked with two handguns not producing all of the evidence that's exculpatory being (\$17,405) leaving out \$7,000 & destroying key evidence (a cellphone) in bad faith without BWC being on for footage ever & without a present supervisor to supervise the illegal acts of misconduct. The state has conspired to cover up the victim's injuries along with ECF by placing the victim in jail in a cell without proper medical. The victim sustained serious physical injuries at 11:06am & the search warrant (SW) was issued without PC after the injuries & const. violations to cover up the acts of misconduct at 11:53am on 9/19/22. I have never called 141 Teeanna Drive my home, I have never told the police that the residence is mine to put on my information as my place of residence, I wasn't in physical possession of any drugs, the residence (Teeanna) is Mr Barlow's home, I he pays his own bills, I'm a visitor and we don't stay together, I wasn't seen placing anything in the house, & I wasn't there for any transaction. The state destroyed potentially exculpatory evidence in bad faith violating my due process rights, & Brady violations by the sheriff's, Christopher Rojas, & Prosecutor Tyler Bryant Brown by destroying a cell phone, stealing money evidence, tampering with witnesses allowed by Judge Keith R Kelly. The state maintained exclusive control over the evidence in which it is useful evidence of purchase of gun receipts, stimulus refund receipts, tax refund receipts, transactions of proof of revenue from babysitting, unemployment benefits, cutting grass, cutting hair, cutting trees, & all lawncare photographs with photographs on my work phone of my money & work done. The smell of hemp/cannabis is similar an isn't enough PC at a home with a closed door & without exigent circumstances. Judge Mark Hayes II wrote a disturbing letter to both my private attorney & PD to inform lawyers not to represent me showing bias & prejudice causing a breakdown in client (criminal def) & assistance of defense counsel (right to counsel). When the government (Judge Hayes II) deliberately interferes with the confidential relationship between a criminal def & defense counsel violations of the 6th amend. rights to counsel prejudices the criminal Def. The judges acts caused the criminal def to fire both lawyers with the breakdown in the relationship leaving the def Pro-se & in jail injured or tortured. Any statement derived from the illegal/unlawful S&S should have been suppressed (state v Luna) with the requested franks hearing (Franks v Delaware) requested before trial because of fruits of a poisonous tree. Due to outrageous government misconduct with Sheriff Chuck Wright being sentenced, in error missed this as apples from the tree of his misconduct. This is an extraordinary circumstance with me being seriously physically injured that can be solved by dismissing the invalid indictments fully that has no PC tickets

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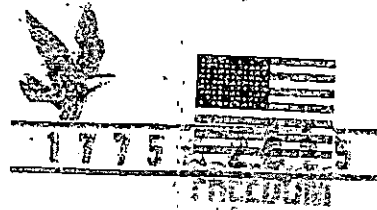
Dismissed, expunged, & also violates the warrant clause by misspelling Mr Brewton's name also making the warrants invalid. I have been injured more & harassed more in jail & outside of jail on bond showing clear violations of my rights that allows me to be immediately released. Due to fast & speedy trial violations with gross negligence also I should be released. The charges should be dismissed completely on the grounds of obstruction of evidence & justice due to evidence being destroyed, tampered with, stolen, & held from the criminal trial. The judge erred in not granting my motions to suppress evidence as fruits of a poisonous tree & evidentiary hearing requested because I had actual & reasonable expectation of privacy in the place searched on the motions should have been granted. There is also misconduct of witness tampering in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1512(b)(1). The suppression of evidence is the destruction of evidence (the cellphone) that occurred or the refusal to give evidence at a criminal trial because it was illegally required (the money). The prosecutors & deputies have violations of obstruction of evidence & justice being the witnesses with mistreatment & me, the prosecutor also intimidated my witness (Annetta Brewton) in a lawyer visit acting like her lawyer extracting information from her before trial perverting the course of justice allowing destroyed evidence in trial, allowing fabricated police reports to obtain a SW to the judge, & witness tampering. The exculpatory evidence was needed to establish this criminal def's innocence. Fed R. Crim. P 16 sites the prosecution has a duty to disclose exculpatory evidence in its possession or control when the evidence may be material to the outcome of the case. The Brady material at hand = brady violations because the evidence was favorable to the accused, it was in the possession of the prosecution, & it was material of guilt or punishment. With evidence of a violation of the Double Jeopardy Clause being subject to the same offense twice with the resisting arrest warrant brought up in trial as a direct indictment but dismissed in preliminary an also expunged by Judge Charles Bagwell. March 25/2026 my rights was violated time after time again not also presenting money as evidence at trial & destroying evidence by the Def(s). This case has violations of the 1st, 4th, 5th, 6th, 8th, & 14th amend of the const. The first violation is the biggest is my due process & brady violations in a court error by the Judge Kelly. The 14th amend. deals with due process, equal protection, & treatment/ punishment while a pretrial detainee. All rights violated but on 3/25/26 due process was violated by Christopher Rojas being a investigator now gang unit deputy lying in police reports, tampering with the scene, destroying Exculpatory evidence that was supposed to be S&S on held by the state for trial, & acts of bad faith. Money & evidence was illegally S&S on there wasn't BNC on 5 min before the S&S or 5 min after the S&S to determine if the S&S was done before or after the SW was issued to view any misconduct of the dep(s) an also to have proof or pictures of the money spread as evidence to show the serial numbers of the old collectable \$50 & \$100 bills with one old 5 dollar bill as my life savings. I was never notified of the civil forfeiture date by mail or by my lawyer. 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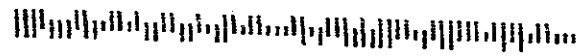

The evidence lost, destroyed, & stolen possessed an exculpatory value apparent before the evidence was suppressed & stolen in that I cannot obtain other evidence of comparable value by other means of picture proof phone numbers of jobs, & receipts. The photographs has exculpatory value that was apparent before they were lost & destroyed. My rights have been violated by deputies using ECF during the arrest & while in custody of Spartanburg Co. Det. Center seen in case # 8:24-cv-07655-RMG-WSB filed in the District Court pending right now leaving me injured taxed many times an event taxed in the shower twice trying to kill me before trial. Me not being notified about the civil forfeiture & not given all my tax return information after being fired as my lawyer to reply to the civil complaint by my lawyer is violating 6th amend. right to counsel & right to ineffective counsel. The counsel performance was deficient & prejudice me with evidence proof of conspiring. The prosecution in this case knowing that Mr Barlows have wasn't mine with a empty guess room with photographs & knowing my real address placed on the PC warrants as evidence but tried to expunge the evidence. 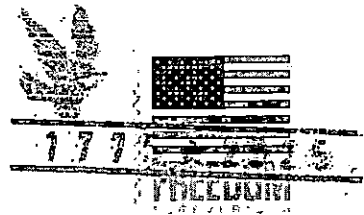

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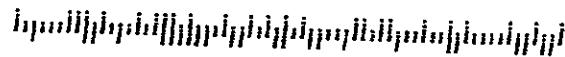

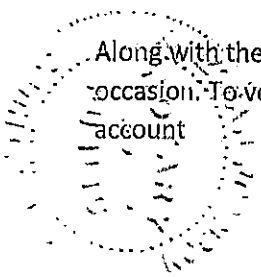

I then backed up as he got up and began to walk away from me. I changed out my taser cartridge and again deployed it on Craig. This was also a good connection that caused Craig to fall to the ground. I knew both of my taser cartridges were now spent and that I had attempted three separate cycles of the taser on Craig. While he was still under the five second cycle I moved in and rolled him over to his stomach. I was then able to apply a handcuff to his right wrist. I held it behind his back until a Good Samaritan, later identified as Harry Snyder, came and assisted me with getting his left hand behind his back. I later obtained a written statement from Mr. Snyder.

I requested EMS for Craig due to him complaining of having trouble breathing. I removed the four taser prongs from Craig's left shoulder and waist area without any issues. I later placed my spent cartridges in evidence and downloaded my taser. When EMS arrived Craig did not wish to have them evaluate him. I then transported him to SRMC per our policy for the taser exposure. When I arrived at the hospital Craig refused to get out of my patrol car at first. I was able to get him in the emergency room but he would not speak to Dr. Ellis. The only complaint he had was of shoulder pain and dehydration but he refused to let hospital staff treat him. Deputy Ingle met us at the hospital and took pictures of Craig. The only visible injuries I observed were abrasions to his knees from falling on the asphalt and the punctures the taser leads left behind. They gave me discharge paperwork and I transported Craig to the detention center without incident.

I presented the facts of this case to the honorable Judge Bagwell and he issued the following warrants on Craig:

- 2022A4210205657 (Resisting Arrest)-(EXPUNGED) *
- 2022A4210205658 (Pedestrian on Highways)-(EXPUNGED) *

During my physical altercation with Craig I gave him the following verbal commands which he ignored:

- Get down X 7

Violent Crime, Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana, and Resisting Arrest¹. The
Defendant's bond was set in the amount of \$6,000 Surety on the PWID Marijuana and Resisting
arrest charge, which was posted on September 20, 2022. Bond was set in the amount of \$25,000
Surety on the Trafficking and Weapon charge which was posted on September 30, 2022. The
Standard condition of Good Behavior was listed on the bond form, as well as special conditions of
no involvement in illegal drug activity, zero tolerance for drugs and/or alcohol, and no firearms
while case remained pending. A-Available Bail Bonding is the surety bondsman on both cases.

While on Bond, on the date of October 18, 2023, Law Enforcement attempted to make a
traffic stop on the Defendant for failing to wear a seatbelt. When the Sheriff's Deputy attempted
to make contact with the vehicle, the Driver fled at a high rate of speed on Old Anderson Mill
Road. Despite Blue Lights and Sirens being activated, the Defendant did not decrease speed or
stop.

attempt to stop until reaching his residence at 333 Bethlehem Church Road. Once the Defendant was out of the vehicle, Law Enforcement attempted to place the Defendant in handcuffs, and were met with him pushing officers away and fighting with them trying to apprehend him. They were ultimately able to subdue him, and he was charged with Failure to Stop for a Blue Light. Bond was set at \$3,000 Surety bond.

These new charges constitute a violation of the defendant's previous bond, and also raise concerns about a continued effort by the Defendant to evade and fight law enforcement officers. He is continuing to show himself as a danger to himself and to others, and the State contends that a violation of bond is appropriate.

This motion is based on the applicable statutes, case law, South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure, and any and all other testimony, exhibits, affidavits and other evidence to be presented at the hearing of this matter.

WHEREFORE, the State prays for an order revoking the Defendant's bond in the above matter, and such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.

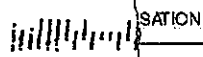

I am employed as an Investigator with the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office and assigned to the Narcotics Division. I have been employed as a law enforcement officer for 17 years and have been specifically investigating narcotic related cases since June of 2015. I received my Basic Law Enforcement Certification at the South Carolina Law Enforcement Academy in Columbia, SC, graduating in June of 2006. Since then, I have attended multiple classes and seminars and have received multiple certifications in areas dealing with the enforcement of the South Carolina Controlled Substances Act {SCCSA}, which included courses conducted at the SC criminal justice academy and other locations across the state. I have supervised or participated in hundreds of controlled narcotic buys, arrests, reversals, and undercover operations.

I further state there is probable cause to search 141 Teeanna Drive Moore, SC for illegal narcotics, specifically marijuana, based on the following facts:

On 09/19/2022 Investigators with the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office Warrant Division and the South Carolina Department of Corrections went to 141 Teeanna Drive to serve an arrest warrant on Marcus Barlow (DOB 04/17/1990) for providing contraband to SCDC inmates. Upon arrival to the residence they knocked on the door which was answered by a resident, Craig Brewton. Investigators identified themselves and Brewton shut the door of the residence and then fled the scene but was detained a short distance away by perimeter units. When Brewton initially opened the door of the residence Deputy Clark observed the odor of Marijuana coming from inside the residence.

I further state probable cause exists, based on the above facts, that illegal narcotics/drugs, specifically marijuana, will be located inside the residence of 141 Teeanna Drive in the Moore community of Spartanburg County, SC and I ask the Honorable Magistrate of Spartanburg County to grant this search warrant.

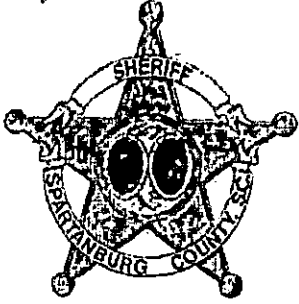

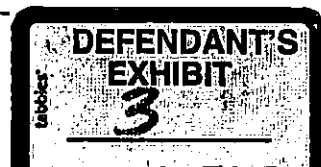

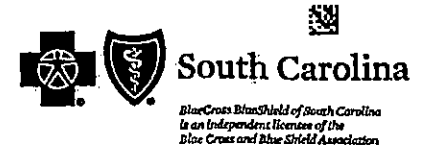

On 10/21/2023, I, Guffey, J. W., began investigating a Citizen's Complaint on a Deputy. The Complainant, identified as Brewton, Craig Ninja Antonio, came to the Sheriff's Office. There asked to file a complaint on Deputies. Mr. Brewton was handed the appropriate forms. They are the SCSO Complaint Report (Official Document). It is to be noted that these forms state the following:

I certify that all statements made by me on this complaint are TRUE and Correct. I understand that knowingly making a false complaint is a violation of South Carolina Code SECTION 16-17-722 and/or SECTION 16-17-725 and is punishable by a fine and not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or by a term of imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. I have read and understood this statement.

Mr. Brewton the sat down and wrote that he had been not only physically assaulted but also sexually assaulted. Mr. Brewton stated that his physical injuries were a dislocated shoulder and a fractured neck. Mr. Brewton also stated that his penis was grabbed twice and that he was "touched on and inside his butt." Mr. Brewton then signed the official document, as did Deputy Bible as a witness. See attached document.

I then viewed the body cam footage of the incident. It was SCSO case number 22090924. The incident date was 09/19/2022. The location was 141 Teeanna Dr., in Spartanburg County. Deputy Smith is seen exiting his patrol vehicle for a warrant service. As he is approaching Mr. Brewton he told him that he was going to be detained. Mr. Brewton immediately ran from Deputy Smith. Deputy Smith pursued Mr. Brewton. He ran all the way to I 26. There Mr. Brewton began walking backwards with his hands on his head, as if he were trying to catch his breath in the emergency lane of I 26. Deputy Smith gave multiple verbal commands for Mr. Brewton to stop and safely move away from the interstate. Mr. Brewton then began walking in the roadway. He was almost struck by several vehicles.

Mr. Brewton then got out of the road and into the grass just past the emergency lane. He was still walking away from Deputy Smith ignoring his verbal commands. At that point Deputy Smith was able to taze Mr. Brewton. Mr. Brewton fell to the ground, but was able to remove one of the probes of the taser. He then began attempting to kick Deputy Smith. Deputy Smith was able to place a new taser cartridge on the taser. Mr. Brewton had gotten back onto his feet. Deputy Smith then tazed Mr. Brewton again. Mr. Brewton fell back to the ground. Deputy Smith was able to place one (1) cuff on Mr. Brewton.

Struggling with Mr. Brewton, a passing citizen stopped and assisted Deputy Smith with cuffing the other wrist. Deputy Smith simply held Mr. Brewton while waiting for additional Deputies to arrive.

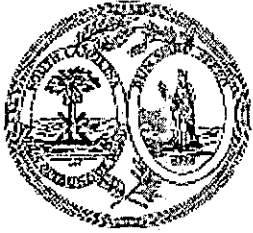
