
## ORDER

---

On January 27, 2026, Appellants Paula M. Strobel and Dorothy Elizabeth Strobel Bell appealed two orders of the circuit court: one denying Appellant Strobel's motion to amend answer and motion for jury trial and the other denying Appellant Strobel's motion to alter or amend. On March 30, 2026, Respondents moved to dismiss the appeal, arguing Appellant Bell lacked standing to appeal and the orders on appeal were interlocutory and not immediately appealable. Appellants filed a reply.

After careful consideration, it appears the orders are subject to immediate appeal. However, this order merely allows the appeal to proceed at this time and does not finally determine whether the underlying order is subject to immediate review.

Nothing prevents Respondents from raising the question of appealability and standing as issues in their appellate brief should Respondents so choose.
