

Counsel for Defendants¹ Chester County School District ("the District"), Defender Services, Inc. ("Defender") and Steve M. Bright have moved the Court for an Order pursuant to Rule 17 (c), SCRPC, to appoint a Guardian ad Litem for Minor Plaintiff A.R.

Rule 17 (c), SCRPC states in part, "The court shall appoint guardian ad litem for a minor or incompetent person not otherwise represented in an action or shall make such order as it deems proper for the protection of the minor or incompetent person." Rule 17(d)(1), SCRPC, permits a minor's natural guardian to be appointed as guardian ad litem only if "he has no interest adverse to that of the person whom he represents in the action."

In this case, Plaintiff's Tanya Murphy ("Murphy") and Minor Plaintiff A.R. ("A.R.") are not represented by counsel. Murphy has advised the Court she intends to proceed to trial *pro se* on the claims attributable to her alleged damages. A.R. is not of the age of majority, thus his

interests cannot be properly presented to the Court without counsel. Since Murphy, A.R.'s mother and natural guardian, has interests potentially adverse to those of A.R, the Court is required to appoint A.R. a guardian ad litem in this case pursuant to Rule 17, SCRPC.

Upon the recommendation of counsel for Defendants, the Court orders Montrie Belton, Esq. to serve as A.R.'s guardian ad litem for the pendency of this action or until A.R. reaches the age of majority. Plaintiff shall bear the costs and fees associated with Mr. Belton's appointment.

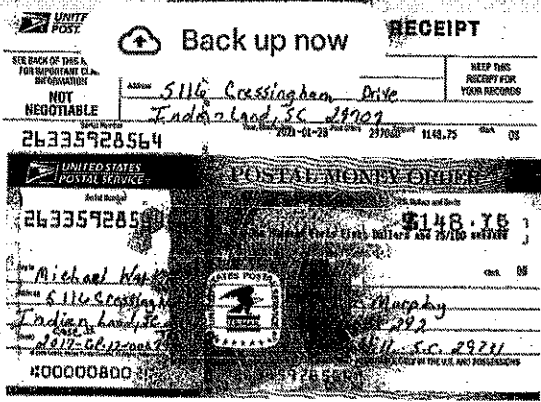

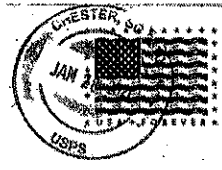
