




accounting in lieu of Petitioner having to serve more formal discovery requests. Petitioner agrees to cooperate with Respondent in procuring needed documents.

Therefore, in accordance with the oral agreements made by the parties on the aforesaid hearing date, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall prepare a full accounting of assets, receipts, and expenses from the date of the sale of the principal's primary residence, which sale is believed to have occurred on May 31, 2019, through the date of the Principal's death, January 15, 2021;
2. Petitioner shall cooperate in procuring documents needed by Respondent in preparing the partial accounting, but it is Respondent's primary obligation to procure needed documents;
3. Respondent shall file said accounting with the Court, and serve Petitioner, within 60 days of the date of this Order;
4. Respondent shall also provide Petitioner all financial records used and referenced in the preparation of said accounting;
5. This Order is issued without prejudice against Petitioner who retains the right to seek a more complete accounting for transactions that may have preceded the date of real estate closing, as is more fully set forth and requested in the claim for relief portion of the Petition, and, Petitioner does not waive the right to file more formal objections to the accounting filed by Respondent filed with the court, and served on Petitioner, on the date of the hearing.
