ORDER

On May 19, 2026, Appellant filed a "notice of conflict of interest," in which he alleges he has a conflict of interest with his counsel and requests the substitution of counsel. On June 3, 2026, Appellant filed "a motion to relieve counsel and appoint new counsel." After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to relieve counsel and substitute appointed counsel is denied. *See State v. Sanders*, 341 S.C. 386, 389, 534 S.E.2d 696, 697 (2000) ("We recognize the Sixth Amendment does not confer an absolute right to be represented by one's preferred attorney.").
