**APPELLANT'S SECOND CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE

AND NOW COMES Appellant Timothy Jones as the Personal Representative for Dewitt Jones ("Mr. Jones"), by and through his undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and moves for an extension of four (4) days additional time to file and serve his Initial Appellant's Brief and Designation of Matter for Inclusion in the Record on Appeal.


