REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION OF ORDERS AND REQUEST FOR
PROPOSED ORDERS

To the Clerk of Court:

Plaintiff respectfully requests clarification concerning the Orders denying injunctive relief entered in this matter.

The record presently contains Orders entered on or about May 7, 2026, and May 26, 2026, concerning the denial of Plaintiff's requests for injunctive relief. Plaintiff is unable to determine from the record which Order corresponds to which Defendant and whether one Order supersedes, supplements, or duplicates the other.

Because Plaintiff has filed an appeal and seeks to preserve all appellate rights, Plaintiff respectfully requests clarification regarding:

1. Which Order applies to Dorchester County;
2. Which Order applies to D.R. Horton, Inc.;
3. Whether the May 26, 2026 Order supplements, amends, replaces, or duplicates the May 7, 2026 Order;
4. Which Order constitutes the final appealable Order as to each Defendant
