**NOTICE OF MULTIPLE INJUNCTION ORDERS,  
FAILURE TO PRODUCE REQUESTED PROPOSED  
ORDERS, PRESERVATION OF APPELLATE  
RIGHTS, REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION OF THE  
RECORD, AND REQUEST FOR INCLUSION IN THE  
RECORD ON APPEAL**

COMES NOW Appellant Attia Elbadawy, appearing pro se, and files this Notice to preserve all appellate rights concerning the injunction-related orders entered in the underlying Quiet Title Action and to ensure a complete record before the South Carolina Court of Appeals.

**I. BACKGROUND**

The injunction issues presently before the Court of Appeals stem from proceedings conducted in the lower court, including matters addressed during and following the September 15, 2025 hearing. Written injunction-denial orders were later entered on May 7, 2026 and another order entered on May 26, 2026. After the Notice of Appeal had been filed on May 22, 2026.

**II. MULTIPLE ORDERS CREATE A RECORD PRESERVATION ISSUE**

Because multiple injunction-related orders exist concerning substantially similar issues, Appellant seeks to preserve all rights concerning both orders and to prevent any future argument that one order amended, replaced, duplicated, superseded, or otherwise extinguished issues raised by the other order.

**III. REQUESTS FOR PROPOSED ORDERS**

Appellant submitted written requests to Dorchester County Attorney Bradley Mitchell and D.R. Horton counsel Mark A. Bible, Jr. seeking copies of the proposed orders associated with the May 7, 2026 and May 26, 2026 injunction-denial orders. Despite repeated requests, the proposed orders have not been produced.

**IV. EFFECT ON APPELLATE REVIEW**

The absence of the proposed orders prevents Appellant from determining whether additional materials were submitted to the lower court in connection with either order and creates uncertainty regarding the complete record available for appellate review.

## V. PRESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Appellant expressly preserves all issues concerning:

- (a) the May 7, 2026 order;
- (b) the May 26, 2026 order;
- (c) any proposed orders;
- (d) any argument that one order superseded or replaced the other;
- (e) the completeness of the appellate record; and
- (f) any issue arising from the failure to produce the requested proposed orders.

**"Appellant reserves the right to supplement this Notice should the requested proposed orders later be produced or otherwise become available."**


## VI REQUEST FOR RELIEF
