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**APPELLANT'S REPLY TO RESPONDENTS' RESPONSE**

**IN OPPOSITION TO**

**APPELLANT'S MOTION TO AUGMENT THE RECORD**

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The Appellant is seeking to introduce emails that are crucial to this appeal because they are directly relevant to demonstrate that the trial Judge denied a continuance to the Appellant and instructed her to argue her Motion during the hearing of August 21, 2025. As reflected in the transcript, Appellant contends that she was repeatedly interrupted during her presentation. The requested documents are essential for this court's full understanding and fair determination of Appellant's appeal, but they were inadvertently not designated for inclusion on the record on appeal. Augmentation of the record will not prejudice any party in any way. The record should therefore be augmented. (SC Rules of Court, 212(b)).

The emails show that the Appellant submitted her Motion to Strike (ROA, pp. 39-55) and Opposition to Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (ROA, pp. 56-60) to Judge Doby two days before the hearing on August 21, 2025. The Appellant filed her Motion to Strike with the Clerk of Court, in lieu of the previous Motion for Sanctions, because she located clear and convincing evidence (ROA, p. 55) that Defendant Wigger was being untruthful when he stated that the Appellant failed to provide him with crucial evidence from the night of the assault, and used this false argument as a reason to improperly attach such evidence to his Answers, directly impacting the Appellant's ability to obtain an expert affidavit. When matters outside the pleadings are presented and not excluded by the Court on a motion under Rule 12(b)(6), the motion must be treated as one for summary judgment under Rule 56. Upon receipt of the Appellant's Motion to Strike and attached evidence, the Appellant contends that because materials outside the pleadings were submitted and not expressly excluded, the Respondents' Motions to Dismiss should have been treated by the trial court as motions for summary judgment pursuant to Rule 12(b), SCRC.

The Respondents are clearly avoiding responsibility and denying the truth when they improperly characterize Appellant's arguments as "only blaming others for not being able to

obtain an expert in this matter”, and also when they allege that the trial Court did not err or abuse its discretion when ordering a dismissal of the Appellant’s case.


The requested documents are relevant because they bear upon issues Appellant intends to raise on appeal concerning the conduct of the proceedings and the denial of a continuance.

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

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

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
