APPELLANT'S SUPPLEMENT TO MOTION TO REINSTATE APPEAL

COMES NOW Appellant Debra Nelson, proceeding pro se, and respectfully supplements her Motion to Reinstate.

Appellant has acted diligently in pursuing this appeal and seeks reinstatement so that the issues raised may be resolved on their merits. Any procedural deficiencies identified by the Court are being promptly addressed. Upon receipt of the Clerk's May 28, 2026 deficiency notice, Appellant immediately took steps to cure the filing-fee deficiency and submits that the interests of justice favor reinstatement.

Appellant further notes that, on June 8, 2026, the Clerk of the Court notified the parties that Respondent's Motion for Costs was filed prematurely pursuant to Rule 222(d), SCACR, and that no further action would be taken on the Respondent's Motion for Costs, Appellant's Return, or Respondent's Reply. Accordingly, no award of costs has been entered in this matter.

Appellant respectfully submits that Respondent will suffer no prejudice from reinstatement of this appeal. Reinstatement will allow the Court to consider the issues presented on their merits rather than on procedural grounds and will promote the fair administration of justice.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant the Motion to Reinstate and permit this appeal to proceed.


