ORDER

On March 31, 2026, Appellant filed a proof of service indicating she served the record on appeal on Respondent on March 30, 2026. On April 28, 2026, Respondent filed a motion seeking to compel a compliant record on appeal and included the served record on appeal as an exhibit. Appellant did not file a return.

After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to compel a compliant record on appeal. Appellant shall serve and file a record on appeal that contains all matters designated by the parties but shall not include matter not presented to the lower court. The record on appeal shall include an index, be arranged as required by Rule 210(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, and be consecutively numbered beginning with the index. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 267. The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal. Matter contained in the Record on Appeal shall be arranged in the following order: the title page, index, orders, judgments, decrees, decisions, pleadings, transcript, charges, and exhibits and other materials or documents. Each page of the Record on Appeal shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the index. Where a portion of a page of the trial transcript, or a page of an exhibit or document, is to be included in the Record on Appeal, the entire page shall be included. When a portion of an order, judgment, decision or pleading is to be included in the Record on Appeal, the entire order, judgment, decision or pleading shall be included in the Record, to include the caption and signature(s) . . ."). Appellant shall serve and file the record on appeal within fifteen days of the date of this order or the appeal

may be dismissed. Final briefs are due twenty days after the record on appeal has been filed with this court.
