This matter is before the Court on a:  Motion to Set Bond  Motion to Revoke Bond

Upon consideration of the arguments of counsel, a review of the record, and relevant factors considered for bond, the Court orders the Motion(s) is hereby  Granted  Denied  Continued to \_\_\_\_\_

Bond is ordered as follows: \$ \_\_\_\_\_  Surety  May Post 10%  PR  Cash / Check.  
 This Order represents one consolidated bond on all the listed charges.  This Order requires separate bonds on each listed charge.  All other bond conditions previously ordered shall be part of this Order.

**General Conditions Imposed** Defendant shall personally appear before the court to answer the charge or indictment and to do and receive what is enjoined by the court, not to leave the State, and be of good behavior toward all the citizens of the State. S.C. Code Ann §§ 17-15-15 and 17-15-20.

**Other Conditions Imposed**

- No Contact, directly, indirectly, and by 3<sup>rd</sup> parties, with  Victim(s) and  Codefendant(s).
- GPS Monitoring at Defendant's expense  Curfew \_\_\_\_\_
- Strict House Arrest - can only leave for school, bona fide verifiable job interview or employment, appointments with lawyer or bondsperson, medical/dental/mental health appointments, emergency medical care, religious services (one per week) and two hours per week to shop for necessities at grocery or other general merchandise store (Walmart, Dollar General, etc.).
- Defendant shall not consume alcohol, use illegal drugs, or abuse prescription drugs while on bond.
- Defendant shall have no firearms or weapons in his/her actual or constructive possession.
- Other conditions: \_\_\_\_\_

The motion has either been withdrawn or counsel failed to appear at the time this matter was scheduled. Therefore, the motion is denied and shall not be rescheduled except as ordered by this Court.

This bond matter was previously heard in the circuit court. The court declines to modify the order of another circuit judge and the request is denied. *Nothing in this order prevents the motion being rescheduled*  
 The Defendant shall not be released until execution and filing of the appropriate bond document with the Court. The Magistrate in bond court may process this paperwork.

COMES NOW the Defendant, Joshua Windfield Drummond, by and through his undersigned counsel, and respectfully moves this Court for reconsideration of Defendant's denial of bond based on a change of circumstances. In support of this Motion, Defendant would show unto the Court the following:

1. On January 23, 2026, the Defendant appeared before the Honorable Jessica Ann Salvini for a reconsideration of bond, at which point the Court denied bond and allowed leave to file for a reconsideration of bond without a change of circumstances.
2. At the above-mentioned bond hearing, the Court noted the Defendant had a hold for Federal Probation that was lifted prior to the bond hearing and indicated the denial of bond was based on the unknown status of Defendant's Federal Probation case.
3. The Defendant would show that his Federal Probation case has been terminated, and the Defendant remains in Greenville County Detention Center without bond on these charges.

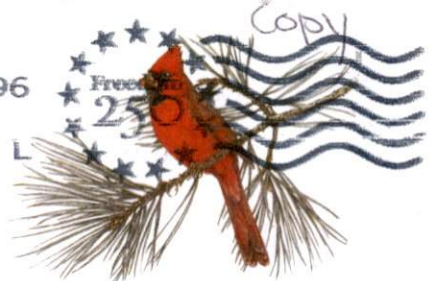
