NOW COME Petitioners, St. George Health Care, LLC, d/b/a St. George Healthcare Center and Vicki Sides, by and through their undersigned counsel, on the grounds stated below, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, as well as the Court's order of July 16, 2014, regarding Extensions in Cases Seeking a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to Review a Decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals, and hereby move for an extension of ten (10) days' time to file/serve their petition to this Court for issuance of a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals to review its decision in this matter.

Pursuant to Rule 242(c), SCACR, the present deadline for the petition for writ of certiorari is Monday, June 15, 2026.
