ORDER

On February 25, 2026, this court ordered Appellant to file an amended record on appeal and directed Respondent to serve and file its final brief within twenty days of the date of service of the amended record on appeal. Appellant then filed an amended record on appeal, this court noted deficiencies, and on March 31, 2026, Appellant filed a corrected amended record on appeal. On April 23, 2026, Appellant filed a "Motion for Failure to Comply w/ Court Order," seeking this court to proceed with consideration of the appeal without Respondents' final brief based on Respondents' failure to serve and file their final brief within twenty days of service of the March 31, 2026 amended record on appeal. Respondents did not file a return; however, on May 7, 2026, Respondents filed their final brief and a motion to file their final brief out of time, explaining ongoing issues with the record on appeal had prevented timely preparation of the final brief. On May 8, 2026, this court granted Respondents' motion to file out of time and accepted Respondent's final brief as filed. After careful consideration, Appellant's April 23, 2026 motion is denied.
