MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Eric Neal Patton respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days from June 11, 2026, until July 13, 2026 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Eric Neal Patton respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of The State v. Desmond Lamar Green with the Supreme Court on June 1, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Joseph Landry with the Court of Appeals on May 22, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of The State v. Jason Barry Bell with the Supreme Court on May 6, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of The State v. Phillip Ryan Lawson with the Supreme Court on April 28, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of The State v. Demetrius Alexander Brown with the Supreme Court on April 20, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of The State v. William McKinney with the Supreme Court on April 16, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Kenya R. Jenkins v. The State with the Supreme Court on April 10, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


