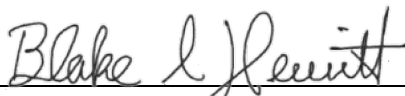
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## ORDER

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Respondent filed a motion to strike Appellant's designation of matter and for Appellant to file an amended initial brief removing all references to any documents struck from the designation of matter. Specifically, Respondent sought to have Items 21-29, 31, and 32 struck from Appellant's designation of matter and to strike Appellant's initial brief at (1) "page 7, paragraph E"; (2) "page 11, line 6"; and (3) "pages 17 through 18, heading VI." Appellant filed a reply in opposition. After careful consideration, we grant in part and deny in part Respondent's motion to strike. Appellant shall file an amended designation of matter striking Items 21-29 and 31 from Appellant's designation of matter. As to Item 32, based on the evidence presented to the court, the court cannot substantiate Respondent's arguments and denies Respondent's motion to strike Item 32 at this time. However, this order does not prohibit Respondent from arguing in her brief that Item 32 was not presented to the lower court and is not properly before this court for review. Additionally, this court grants Respondent's motion to strike portions of Appellant's initial brief that reference the struck Items.

Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file: (1) an amended designation of matter striking Items 21-29 and 31 from Appellant's designation of matter, and (2) an amended initial brief to omit references the struck Items specifically at (1) "page 7, paragraph E"; (2) "page 11, line 6"; and (3) "pages 17 through 18, heading VI."
