This matter is before this Court upon Defendant's Motion for Reconsideration of the Order denying Defendant's Motion to Dismiss filed on April 2, 2026 pursuant to Rule 59(e) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure (SCRCP), which was timely filed with the Court on April 9, 2026.
