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Good afternoon, and happy Friday. I hope this correspondence finds you well.

We just received the attached Deficiency Letter, which indicates that our Notice of Appeal (attached) was deficient because the Proof of Service was not "signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR."

However, I have reviewed the proof of service to the Notice of Appeal (attached) and it appears to comply with Rule 267(b).

Rule 267(b) states,

"Signatures. A document filed with the appellate court shall be signed by the lawyer or the self-represented litigant filing the document. In addition to a traditional hand-written signature, a lawyer or self-represented litigant may sign a document using "s/ [typed name of person]," a signature stamp, or a scanned or other electronic version of the person's signature. Regardless of form, the signature shall act as a certificate that the person has read the document; that to the best of the person's knowledge, information, and belief there is good ground to support it; and that the document is not interposed for delay."

Rule 267(b) states that an attorney "may sign a document using "s/ [typed name of person]," which is what is contained on the Proof of Service (attached) – s/ Michael E. Patterson, Jr.

Thus, I do not understand where the deficiency lies. Respectfully, I would request clarification on the deficiency identified in the Deficiency Letter to ensure that we address it.
