MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPEAL

as follows:

1. This appeal arises from the Charleston County Court of Common Pleas, the Honorable Deadra L. Jefferson presiding, Circuit Court Case No. 2025-CP-10-00921, and is pending before this Court as Court of Appeals Case No. 2025-002194.
2. Appellant filed this appeal from the Circuit Court's order affirming the Charleston County School District Board of Trustees' decision regarding Appellant's employment.
3. The parties previously advised this Court that the parties had reached a tentative settlement agreement intended to include a global resolution of the parties' disputes, including this appeal, and Appellant moved for a stay of appellate deadlines pending finalization of that settlement.
4. Appellant now seeks to withdraw and dismiss this appeal. Counsel for Respondent consents to this Motion and to each party bearing its own costs and fees incurred on appeal.
5. Rule 260(c), SCACR, provides that an appeal may be dismissed on motion of the appellant upon such terms as may be fixed by the Court. Rule 222(a), SCACR, further provides that costs are taxed as ordered by the appellate court or as agreed by the parties.
6. Appellant respectfully requests that the Court enter an order dismissing this appeal, with each party responsible for its own costs and fees incurred on

appeal.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant this Motion and enter an order dismissing this appeal, with each party responsible for its own costs and fees.
