**APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ORDER THE
TRANSCRIPT**

Appellant, through her undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 207, SCACR, respectfully moves this Honorable Court for permission to order the transcript outside of the deadline.

One June 4, 2026, Appellant's counsel received a letter from the Clerk of the South Carolina Court of Appeals advising that the time to order the transcript had expired and directing counsel, if the transcript had not been timely ordered, to "serve and file a motion requesting permission to order the transcript outside of the filing deadline set by Rule 207 of the SCACR, along with a copy of your letter addressed to the court reporter." On June 5, 2026, Appellant's counsel ordered the transcript.

Appellant acknowledges that the transcript order did not occur within the original deadline contemplated by Rule 207, SCAR, but respectfully submits that the delay was not the result of bad

faith and that Appellant accepted expeditiously once the issue was brought to counsel's attention. Granting this motion will not prejudice Respondent.

Appellant therefore respectfully requests that the Court grant permission for Appellant to order the transcript outside of the deadline, deem the June 5, 2026, transcript order as proper, and allow the appeal to proceed on the merits.
