**RE: Emergency Request to Stay Writ of Ejectment / Continue Appeal

To the Honorable Judge:

My name is Cornelius McClary. I am respectfully asking the Court to consider stopping the Writ of Ejectment and allowing my appeal and requested jury trial to continue.

I attended my bond hearing and I followed the Court's instructions by making my first escrow payment of \$1,000 on May 19, 2026. My wife later asked about the next payment date and we understood that we would be contacted with further instructions. We did not receive a written payment schedule or further notice explaining when the next escrow payment was due.

The missed June payment was not intentional. My family and I are dealing with a difficult financial situation involving my disability benefits. I receive SSDI, and I have also been dealing with SSI-related matters. We have been trying to manage our household expenses while making sure we comply with the Court.

I live in the home with my wife and children, and losing the home immediately would create a serious hardship for my family.

I am prepared to pay \$400 toward the missed escrow payment immediately, and I respectfully request 7 days to pay the remaining balance owed.

I also respectfully ask the Court to allow my appeal and jury trial request to move forward because I have a dispute regarding the amount owed, including charges connected to utilities under my lease.

I apologize for the missed payment and ask the Court for an opportunity to correct this issue. I am not refusing to pay; I am asking for a short opportunity to catch up and keep my family housed while the appeal is

pending.
