**EMERGENCY MOTION TO COMPEL
DORCHESTER COUNTY THIRD PARTY
RESPONDENT TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF**

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1. On April 17, 2026, Appellants filed a Motion requesting correction of the caption and supplementation of the Record on Appeal.
2. On or about April 20, 2026, Appellants served Dorchester County with a Notice of Correction of Caption, Motion to Supplement the Record on Appeal, and Appellants' Initial Brief.
3. Since service of those documents, Dorchester County has not filed an Initial Brief, Response Brief, or other appellate brief addressing the issues raised by Appellants.
4. Dorchester County has been involved in the underlying litigation from which this appeal arises.
5. On October 11, 2024, Respondent D.R. Horton asserted claims against Dorchester County as a third-party defendant in the underlying action.
6. During the January 21, 2025 hearing concerning injunctive relief, Dorchester County appeared through its attorney, Bradley A. Mitchell, and participated in the proceedings.
7. On or about June 17, 2025, Dorchester County filed an Answer and Reply to D.R. Horton's claims against Dorchester County in the lower court proceedings.
8. Dorchester County was identified in Appellants' Notice of Appeal and has knowledge of the matters presented in this appeal.
9. Dorchester County possesses a direct interest in issues raised on appeal, including issues relating to Wise Lane and county actions affecting the rights of the parties.

ARGUMENT

10. Appellants respectfully submit that Dorchester County's participation throughout the underlying proceedings demonstrates that Dorchester County is not a stranger to this litigation.
11. Dorchester County has been served with appellate filings and has been aware of this appeal for many months.
12. To date, Dorchester County has not filed an Initial Brief addressing the merits of the appeal.
13. The absence of a brief from Dorchester County deprives Appellants and this Court of Dorchester County's position regarding the issues presented.
14. Dorchester County is a party of this appeal, Dorchester County should be required to participate fully in the appellate process, including filing an Initial Brief.

RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, Appellants respectfully request that this Court:

- A. Enter an Order compelling Dorchester County to file its Initial Brief within a time period established by the Court;
- B. Rule upon Appellants' pending Motion regarding correction of the caption and supplementation of the record;
- C. Grant such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
