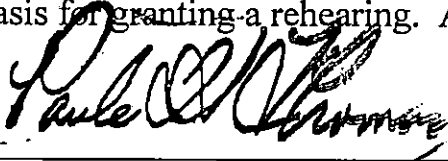

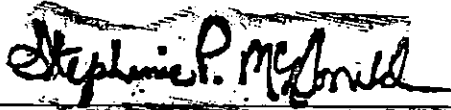

ORDER

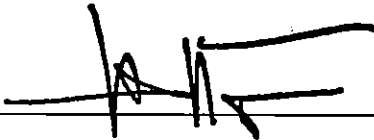
