MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Antonio D. Scott respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Antonio D. Scott respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Emanuel Bedford with the Court of Appeals on June 8, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Don Leequin Brown with the Court of Appeals on May 21, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Willie Smith with the Court of Appeals on May 14, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Adrian McManus with the Court of Appeals on May 14, 2026. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Jonathan Dawkins with the Supreme Court on May 8, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Michael Daugherty v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 8, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Courtney Register with the Court of Appeals on May 5, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


