**MOTION FOR PERMISSION TO FILE
TRANSCRIPT REQUEST OUT OF
TIME**

COMES NOW Appellant, Shaunise Nelson, appearing pro se, and respectfully requests permission to file the transcript request out of time and states as follows:

1. This appeal arises from Berkeley County Court of Common Pleas Case No. 2025-CP-08-01090.
2. On March 18, 2026, Appellant requested the transcript of the December 16, 2025 hearing before the Honorable Thomas J. Rode.
3. Court Administration acknowledged receipt of the transcript request on March 18, 2026 and assigned Transcript Request ID No. 1651391874.
4. The transcript request was submitted on an expedited basis.
5. Court Administration issued notice that the transcript had been requested and transmitted notice to counsel associated with the case.
6. Appellant subsequently paid the required transcript fee and has attached proof of payment.
7. At the time the transcript was requested, Appellant believed that requesting the transcript, paying the required fee, and the notification generated through Court Administration satisfied the applicable transcript-ordering requirements.
8. Appellant requested the transcript before filing the Notice of Appeal and believed in good faith that the transcript had been properly and timely ordered.
9. Appellant did not intentionally fail to comply with Rule 207, SCACR, nor did Appellant intend to delay the appellate process.
10. Upon receiving the Court's deficiency notices, Appellant promptly provided proof of the transcript request, proof of payment, and has now provided proof of service upon opposing counsel.
11. Any deficiency was the result of a good-faith misunderstanding regarding the procedural requirements and not due to willful noncompliance or neglect.

12. Respondents will suffer no prejudice if this Motion is granted because:

- a. the transcript was requested;
- b. the transcript fee was paid;
- c. notice of the transcript request was provided; and
- d. Appellant has promptly acted to cure any procedural deficiency identified by the Court.

13. Appellant respectfully submits that the interests of justice favor resolution of this appeal on the merits rather than dismissal based upon a curable procedural issue.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court:

- A. Grant Appellant permission to file the transcript request out of time pursuant to Rule 207, SCACR;
- B. Accept the attached transcript request confirmation, proof of payment, and proof of service as curing the deficiencies identified by the Court;
- C. Permit this appeal to proceed; and
- D. Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
