South Carolina Legal Services: Provides a variety of free legal services (but not for criminal cases). Eligibility for assistance through SCLS depends on your income and assets and the type of legal problem you have. Based on your inputs during this session, it appears that you may qualify for SCLS. South Carolina Bar Lawyer Referral Service: A service of the South Carolina Bar. Each participating private lawyer agrees to charge no more than \$50 for a 30-minute consultation. If the consultation extends past the 30 minutes, or you hire the lawyer to represent you, the lawyer will charge you his or her normal fees. The lawyers do not take pro bono (no-fee) cases.
