Notice of Appeal

Notice is hereby given that Thomas Thompson #80681 does hereby appeal the final decision of the Administrative Law Court dated November 26, 2013 and received on December 4, 2013, a copy of which is attached. A general statement of the grounds for appeal is:

The Administrative Law Judge denied Appellant's appeal based on the fact that the SCDPPPS had stated that its decision was made considering the factors outlined in section 24-21-640 and the fifteen factors published in its parole form. Appellant challenges the validity of that statement and proposes to present proof to the contrary. Appellant also proposes that the SCDPPPS' continued "rubber stamping" denial of parole infringes on his right to Equal Justice and may be construed as Cruel and Unusual Punishment in light of recent U.S. Supreme Court rulings concerning the sentencing of juveniles in adult court.


