MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from June 18, 2026, until July 20, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

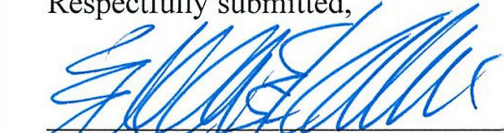
previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David Stowers with the Court of Appeals on June 12, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Christian Scowcroft v. State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David Matthews with the Court of Appeals on May 29, 2026. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Jeremy Cornish with the Court of Appeals on May 28, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Jordan M. Hodge v. State with the Supreme Court on May 12, 2026. Counsel will file the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Mack Davis on April 29, 2026, with the Court of Appeals. Counsel will file the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Charles Ivey on April 29, 2026, with the Court of Appeals. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Lawton L. Holloway v. State with the Court of Appeals on April 20, 2026. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Marlo Jackson on April 15, 2026, with the Court of Appeals.

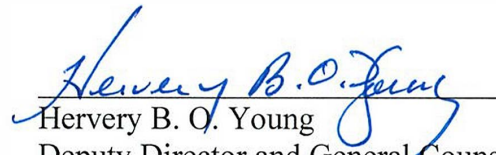

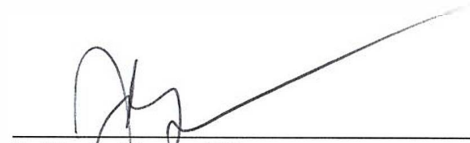

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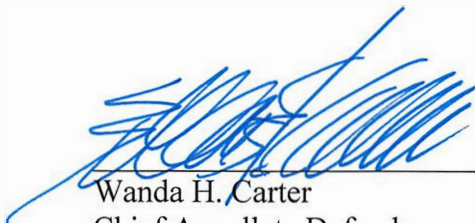
