On March 3, 2026, Defendants Clements Electrical, Inc., Alton Frederick Clements, Jr., Janet Gay Clements, Jason Dix, and Nicholas Behringer filed a Motion to Reconsider the February 26, 2026 Order of this Court. The Court has since discovered a new material fact that was unknown at the time the February 26, 2026 Order was entered. A status conference was held via Webex to address this matter on March 3rd, 2026. Attorney Scott Giblin appeared for the Defendants. Attorney Ashaley Boatwright appeared for the Plaintiff.
