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Dear Clerk of Court,

I am writing to respectfully request an update on the status of the Petition for Rehearing and/or Motion for Reconsideration I filed in the above-referenced matter.

As previously noted in my filings, there is a terminal academic deadline of today, June 15, 2026, which is critical for my law school matriculation for the 2026 cycle. I have no other viable options to compel the University of South Carolina to correct my academic records, and this court is the only forum with the authority to address the procedural deadlock preventing this correction.
