Dear Judge Curry and Ms. Howard:

The above-referenced consolidated cases are pending before Judge Curry in the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina, Aiken Division, and before the Supreme Court of South Carolina on two certified questions from the District Court.

Pursuant to Rule 244(b), SCACR, and on behalf of Defendants SRP Federal Credit (“SRP”), I am writing to “notify” the Supreme Court and the District Court that SRP “believes that additional materials from the record before the certifying court are necessary” to the Supreme Court’s consideration of the certified questions before it.

Specifically, SRP requests that the District Court provide the Supreme Court with the three briefs and accompanying exhibits filed in relation to SRP’s Motion to Compel Arbitration. See ECF Nos. 53, 58, & 59. The exhibits that SRP submitted to the District Court are particularly important to the questions before the Supreme Court on contract formation, and SRP believes the Supreme Court should have the chance to review the relevant documents—membership applications, membership agreements, and change-in-terms notice—as a whole, rather than as excerpts currently provided in the District Court’s certifying order.

SRP would respectfully request that the District Court consider this request to provide additional documents to the Supreme Court for review. So the District
