**MOTION TO FILE OUT OF TIME
AND
MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO ORDER TRANSCRIPT**

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests this Court allow the filing of this second motion out of time and extend any time for ordering the transcript in this matter.

Counsel's representation agreement did not cover an appeal from the verdict in this matter. He has sent an affidavit of indigency to Ms. Vilardi and understands that affidavit was recently received by the Office of Appellate Defense and her application for representation by that office is being processed.

In order for the Office of Appellate Defense to complete its process regarding its representation of Ms. Vilardi, counsel requests an additional 30 days to order the transcript. This will give an appropriate amount of time to determine and complete any representation issues.

Additionally, as counsel previously explained, it does not appear that this request would cause any delay in the case. A different party appears to have ordered the transcript, and the court reporter has requested an extension, so Ms. Vilardi's eventual order will not affect the time for preparing the transcript.

Counsel respectfully requests this Court excuse the late filing and allow consideration of the request for an extension and extend the time for ordering the transcript to Monday, July 20, 2026, so that the parties can ensure Vilardi is properly represented on appeal.
