MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Willie Goodwin respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until January 26, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. 

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




