THIS MATTER CAME BEFORE THIS COURT on April 11th, 2025, for two motions hearings: (1) Defendant Michael Lee Freeman's (hereinafter "Defendant") *Motion to Compel Discovery and Disclosure of Evidence*, filed by and through their counsel on March 12th, 2025, and (2) the State's *Motion to Require DNA Samples with Affidavit* as filed on April 4th, 2025. Present at the hearing were Defendant and counsel, Assistant Public Defenders Kaitlin A. Diaz and Anastasia L. Walker, and Assistant Solicitor Meghan A. Gasser representing the State.

Regarding Defendant's *Motion to Compel Discovery and Disclosure of Evidence*, the Court determined that the State respond to Defendant's Discovery Request within thirty (30) days of the motion hearing, to include disclosures, status updates, and/or proposed legal objections with authority opposing disclosure. During the hearing, Defense counsel requested additional discovery materials during that hearing and further indicated that said requests would be memorialized and filed in writing.

Regarding the State's *Motion to Require DNA Samples with Affidavit*, the State requested that this motion be continued due to time constraints on April 11th, 2025. Over Defense counsel's objection, the Court granted the State's request for a continuance of said motion. Upon agreement by the State and Defense, the State's Motion to Require DNA Samples shall be

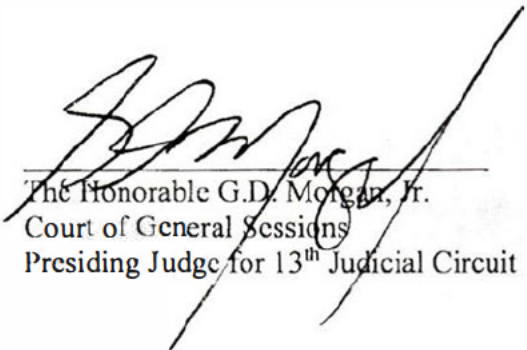
rescheduled for the motions docket occurring during the week of June 9th, 2025, term of Greenville County General Sessions Court in to allow sufficient time for the State to present in-court testimony in support of their motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Assistant Solicitor Gasser respond to Defendant's discovery requests set forth in the *Motion to Compel Discovery and Disclosure of Evidence* within thirty (30) days of the motion hearing, to include disclosures, status updates, and/or proposed legal objections with authority opposing disclosure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defense counsel submit requests made orally during the April 11th, 2025, hearing in writing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the State's *Motion to Require DNA Samples with Affidavit* shall be rescheduled for the motions docket occurring during the week of June 9th, 2025, term of Greenville County General Sessions Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
