According to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, a notice of appeal must include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; a statement of when the appealing party received the decision from which the appeal is taken; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. A copy of the order being challenged on appeal, and a certificate of service showing the notice has been timely served on all respondents, and must accompany the notice of appeal.
