IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:  See attached order (formal order to follow)  Statement of Judgment by the Court: This case came before the Court on November 14, 2013, on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss/Judicial Assistance, Plaintiff's Response to Motion to Dismiss (incorrectly titled Motion to Strike), and Plaintiff's Motion for Common Law Hearing/Jury Trial. The Court, after hearing argument and reviewing the filed documents, hereby GRANTS Defendant's Motion to Dismiss and thus Plaintiff's Motion for Common Law Hearing/Jury Trial is hereby rendered MOOT. The Court granted Defendant's Motion to Dismiss based on insufficiency of service of process pursuant to SCRPC Rule 12(b)(5), failure to state a claim under SCRPC Rule 12(b)(6), and the doctrine of res judicata as analyzed by the South Carolina Supreme Court in Johnson v. Greenwood Mills, Inc., 317 S.C. 248, 250, 462 S.E.2d 832, 833 (1994).
