COMES NOW the Plaintiff, appearing Pro Se, and respectfully files this Notice of Appellant Noncompliance and Objection to Extension of Time.

1. Plaintiff obtained a lawful judgment in the underlying action and is the prevailing party in this matter.
2. Appellant filed an Emergency Motion to Stay and was ordered by the Court to pay the required filing fee within fifteen (15) days.
3. The Court-established deadline expired without payment of the required fee.
4. Rather than complying with the Court's deadline, Appellant sought an extension of time after the expiration of the payment period.
5. Plaintiff objects to the requested extension because Appellant has failed to demonstrate sufficient good cause for additional delay.
6. This request for additional time is consistent with Appellant's prior pattern of untimely payments and repeated requests for extensions during the tenancy.
7. Throughout the tenancy, Appellant routinely failed to satisfy financial obligations in a timely manner and frequently required additional time to make payments.
8. Plaintiff has suffered and continues to suffer financial hardship as a result of Appellant's repeated delays, late payments, and failure to timely satisfy obligations.
9. The continued delay in this matter unfairly prejudices Plaintiff as the prevailing party by preventing final resolution of the case and delaying enforcement of the judgment.
10. Plaintiff respectfully submits that court deadlines should be enforced and that repeated extensions without demonstrated good cause undermine the orderly administration of justice.
11. To date, Appellant has been afforded an opportunity to comply with the Court's payment order but has failed to do so within the time provided.
12. Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court consider Appellant's history of delay, failure to meet deadlines, and ongoing noncompliance when evaluating the request for additional time and the pending Emergency Motion to Stay.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Court:

- A. DENY Appellant's request for an extension of time;
- B. DENY Appellant's Emergency Motion to Stay;
- C. Determine that Appellant has failed to comply with the Court's payment deadline;
- D. Dismiss the appeal and/or strike the Emergency Motion to Stay should Appellant fail to satisfy all filing requirements as ordered by the Court; and
- E. Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
