NOTICE OF APPELLANT'S NONCOMPLIANCE

COMES NOW the Plaintiff/Respondent, Zack Alleyne, appearing Pro Se, and respectfully provides notice to the Court regarding Appellant's failure to comply with the Court's requirements concerning proof of service.

1. Plaintiff is the prevailing party in the underlying action and is currently defending against Appellant's appeal and related motions.

- D. Deny any further relief until Appellant has complied with all applicable filing and service requirements; and
- E. Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
